- Please arrive early to allow plenty of time to pick up race items. There will be two races picking up at this tent.

#### Packet Pickup with a Kids of STEEL Team

 Some Kids of STEEL teams may participate in advanced packet pickup at the expo. You will hear from your site coordinator if this is the case.

5K numbers (your bib number) will be organized by race number instead of alphabetical by last name. Please bring the email with your race number for faster service. Race numbers are also available for look-up by visiting the Race Number Look-Up kiosks at the expo.



## Race Bibs/Race Numbers

- Runners 13 years and younger will receive a blue bib. Runners over the age of 14 will
  receive a yellow race bib.
  - A reunion area will be located within the finish line chute area, near the exit on Stanwix and the north side of Blvd of the Allies. This area is available for runners 13 and under to reunite with family members that they ran with and/or those who did not run with them. Volunteers will be available at the chute exit to assist young runners who are waiting for their parents/guardians to meet them.
- Prior to the race, parents of young runners should make a meet-up plan for after the race. Additional recommendations include:
  - Make sure young runner has a parent/guardian cell phone number with them or listed on their race bib.
  - Establish a meeting area ahead of time.
