

The Chick-fil-A Pittsburgh Kids Marathon



Date: Saturday, May 6, 2023
Time: First heat starts at 9:30 AM
Start Line: In front of PNC Park on West General Robinson
Finish Line: Boulevard of the Allies between the blocks of Wood and Market Street (Downtown).

Please adhere to directions provided by event staff and race day security during the event. Their goal is to keep all runners safe and to unite children with their adults in the designated areas.

Packet Pick Up

- FRIDAY, May 5 from 11:00 AM – 8:00 PM**
 - The Chick-fil-A Pittsburgh Kids Marathon booth at the 2023 Pittsburgh Health & Fitness Expo at the David L. Lawrence Convention Center.
- SATURDAY, May 6, from 7:30 AM - 10:15 AM**
 - Look for the Registration tent in **Red Lot 5** at the corner of West General Robinson Street and Mazeroski Way. Please arrive early to allow plenty of time to pick up your race items.
- Packet Pickup with a Kids of STEEL Team**
 - Some sites may participate in advanced packet pickup with their Kids of STEEL team. You will hear from your Kids of STEEL site coordinator if this is the case.

Bibs/Bib Numbers

- All youth registrants will receive two matching bibs: one for them and one for the adult.
 - Bring BOTH bibs on race day. The child will wear the **RED bib** and the adult will wear the **BLUE bib**.
 - Fill out the emergency contact information on the back of both bibs. Be sure to include the cell phone of the adult running with the child.
- There will be a checkpoint to get into the corrals. For safety and organization of the start line, only children and adults with a Kids Marathon bib will be permitted in the corrals, even if the adult doesn't intend to run the race.
- If you will have a child in a baby carrier (ex. baby sling, baby wrap, or backpack), you must complete a liability waiver at the registration tent and receive a bib number for them. They will not receive a shirt, medal, or goody bag. You may print one out here and turn it in at the registration tent.



New Sensory Inclusive Heat

- During the start of this heat, the music volume will be lowered, activities will be reduced, and personal space will be increased for participants. This heat is perfect for participants with sensory sensitivities or other individualized needs making this event accessible to all. Check the heat schedule for the specific starting time. Prior to the start of this heat, individuals with sensory sensitivities can visit the Kulture City Tent in Red Lot 5 and utilize sensory bags to help lessen sensory overload. [Learn more here.](#)

- Strollers or baby joggers are not allowed into the corral area or on the racecourse. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller skates, or rollerblades are also not permitted.
 - There are no water stops on the Kids Marathon course. Water will be available in the finish line chute. You are welcome to bring your own water.
 - Please make sure your bib is visible while on the course.
 - If you want to watch your child from the sidewalk near the finish line, remain on the north side of the Blvd. of the Allies - the same side of the street where Point Park University's Academic Hall is located. [View a map of these spectator locations HERE.](#)

Finish Line Information

- There is a designated waiting area in the finish line chute for adults and children to be reunited. Tell your child to look for the "Waiting Area" signs after the finish line. If separated on the course volunteers will direct kids to this area to be reunited.
- Do not leave the finish line chute without your child. There is no re-entry back into the finish line chute.
- If you are running with your child, volunteers will check both you and your child for matching bibs.
- If you are running with more than one child, you must have the matching adult bib for each child.
- If you are not running with your child, detach the 'Kid Claim' tag from the child's bib before the race and plan to meet them in the Family Reunion area at the exit of the finish line chute on the Blvd. of the Allies. Volunteers will check 'Kid Claim' tags to make sure they match before allowing you to leave the Family Reunion area. If you have more than one child to claim from the Family Reunion area, have the 'Kid Claim' tag for each child accessible.
- Please be patient with our Family Reunion and exiting process, it is for the safety of the children. We designed the finish line chute with safety and efficiency in mind. Please do not reach over or move barriers to exit. Please keep moving forward after crossing the finish line and wait for others in the designated waiting area.
